

MMF 50/50 Raffle 2010 Rules and Conditions

1. Every ticket in the MMF 50/50 Raffle 2010 will cost \$10. Payment may be made in cash or by check, but not by credit card.
2. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years or older. Anyone under 18 may receive a raffle ticket as a gift and is therefore eligible to collect the prize. Regular staff of MMF will not be eligible.
3. There will be only one prize.
4. Monies raised by the MMF 50/50 Raffle 2010 will be applied as follows: 50% of the total receipts will be given to the winner and 50% will go to MMF Funds.
5. Any costs of running the raffle will be borne by MMF.
6. The amount won will solely depend on how many tickets are sold. Taxes are the responsibility of the winner.
7. The draw will be made at the MMF concert performance on the evening of Thursday, August 5, 2010. One ticket will be picked out at random. A second ticket will be drawn as a reserve winner. The result of the draw will be final.
8. The prize-winner need not be present at the draw. If not present, MMF will make every effort to contact the person concerned using the contact details provided on the winning ticket.
9. To claim the prize, the winner must present photo-identification to Patti Morneault, Business Manager of MMF, (802-362-1956) as proof that he/she is the person named on the winning ticket or properly represents the winner, and must sign a receipt for the money received.
10. If the winner does not collect the prize by the end of the day on August 31, the amount will be given to the reserve winner.
